PILLOW TALK

9" x 12"

February

SUPPLIES:

- One pink-dotted fat quarter.
- White fabric approximately 10" x 7".
- Assorted brown, tan, and pink fabrics. We used 8 different fabrics. This is a great project to use scraps of silk, satin, velveteen, corduroy, home-dec fabrics, et cetera.
- Dark pink embroidery floss.
- Cotton batting approximately 10" x 3".
- Pencil
- Embroidery needle.
- Clover Quick Yo-Yo Makers (Small heart and small round).



- 10" x 13" pillow form. See www.patchplayquilting.com for a free pattern for the pillow form.

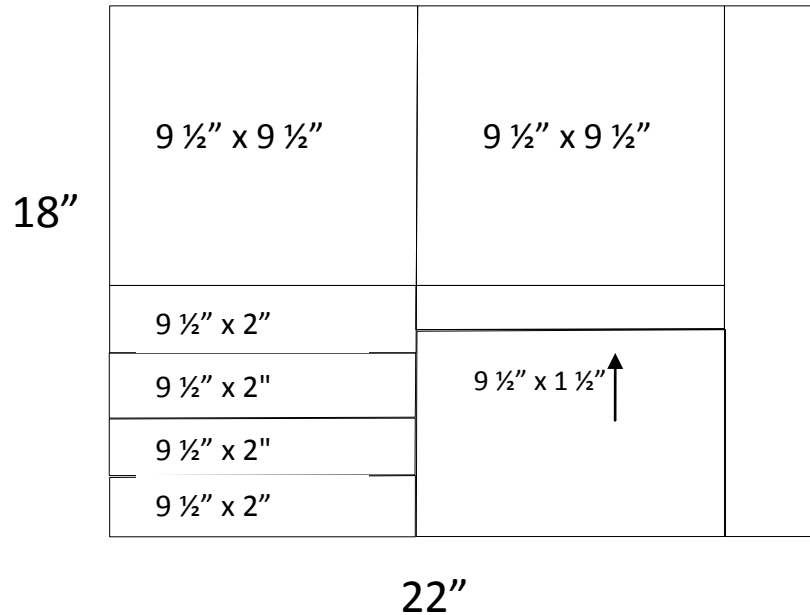
INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut one 10" x 3" piece from white fabric. Trace the embroidery design found at the end of these instructions on this piece of fabric using a light box or window.
2. Place the 10" x 3" piece of batting behind the 10" x 3" piece of white fabric. Pin if needed.
3. Embroider the words and the hearts with two strands of the dark pink floss. You will be embroidering through the batting as well. Trim this piece to 9½" x 2½".

4. Using the Clover Quick Yo-Yo makers and following their instructions, make 25 small assorted brown/tan round yo-yos and three small pink heart-shaped yo-yos.

4. Cut one $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " piece from white fabric.

5. Cut pink-dotted fat quarter following diagram below.



11. Sew the $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the bottom of the embroidered word strip. Then sew the white strip ($9\frac{1}{2}$ " by $3\frac{1}{2}$ "") to the bottom of that $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

12. Sew a $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" strip to the top of the embroidered word strip and to the bottom of the white strip.

13. Sew a $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" strip to each side.

14. Using the picture as your guide, hand-sew yo-yos to bottom white strip. They overlap a little bit. This will complete the pillow top.

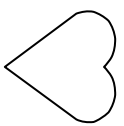
14. Press a double $\frac{1}{2}$ " inch hem on one side of both $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Sew along this folded edge.

15. With right sides together pin a $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the pillow top along one short side. Pin the second $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the other short side of the pillow top. The hem edges should overlap in the middle. Sew around all four sides of the pillow top.

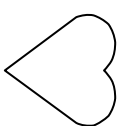
16. Turn right sides out. Smooth out corners with a blunt pair of scissors. Insert pillow form.
