



# PATCHPLAY

PILLOW TALK

## SUPPLIES:

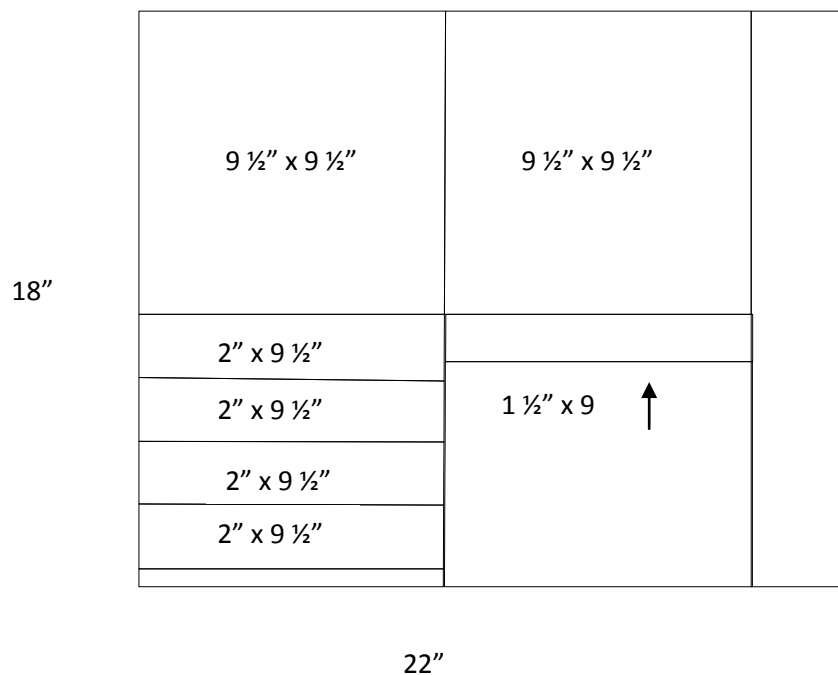
- One yellow print fat quarter.
- Solid white fabric approximately 10" x 10".
- One 4" x 4" piece of each of the following fabrics: purple print, yellow print, blue print, pink print.
- Shapeplay Templates in the following sizes: 1" wedge, 1" oval, 2 1/2" flower and 1 1/2" flower. See [www.patchplayquilting.com](http://www.patchplayquilting.com) to get all of the Shapeplay Templates free.
- Light brown embroidery floss.
- Pink embroidery floss.
- Yellow embroidery floss.
- Three 3/4" yellow buttons.
- Fusible web.
- Iron
- Sharp scissors.
- Cotton batting approximately 10" x 3".
- Pencil
- Embroidery needle.
- 10" x 13" pillow form. See [www.patchplayquilting.com](http://www.patchplayquilting.com) for a free pattern for the pillow form.

Note: We used 30's reproduction fabrics to give this pillow an old fashioned look.

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut one 10" x 3" piece from white fabric. Trace the embroidery design found at the end of these instructions on this piece of fabric using a light box or window.
2. Place the 10" x 3" piece of batting behind the 10" x 3" piece of white fabric. Pin if needed.
3. Embroider the words with two strands of the light brown floss and the flowers with two strands of the pink and yellow floss, using a backstitch. You will be embroidering through the batting as well. Trim this piece to 9½" x 2½".
4. From white fabric cut a 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" strip of fabric.
5. Trace the following Shapeplay Templates on the paper side of fusible web: seven 1" wedges, six 1" ovals, one 2 1/2" flower and one 1 1/2" flower.

6. Cut around the shapes leaving approximately 1/4". Remove the paper backing and iron each shape to the correct fabric. Use the picture as a guide.
7. Cut out each shape on the traced line and using the picture as a guide iron the flowers and flower petals to the 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" strip of white fabric.
8. Cut the yellow fat quarter following the diagram below.

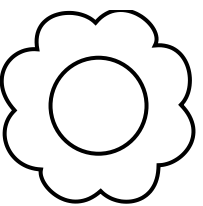


9. Sew the 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" yellow strip to the bottom of the embroidered word strip.
10. Sew the flower strip to the bottom of the 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" green strip.
11. Sew a 2" x 9 1/2" strip to the top of the embroidered word strip and to the bottom of the flower strip.
12. Sew a 2" x 9 1/2" strip to each side.
13. Sew the three 3/4" buttons to the center of the flowers. This completes the pillow top.

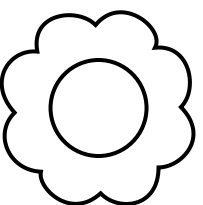
13. Press a double  $\frac{1}{2}$ " inch hem on one side of both  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Sew along this folded edge.
14. With right sides together pin a  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the pillow top along one short side. Pin the second  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the other short side of the pillow top. The hem edges should overlap in the middle. Sew around all four sides of the pillow top.
15. Turn right sides out. Smooth out corners with a blunt pair of scissors. Insert pillow form.
