PILLOW TALK

9" x 12"

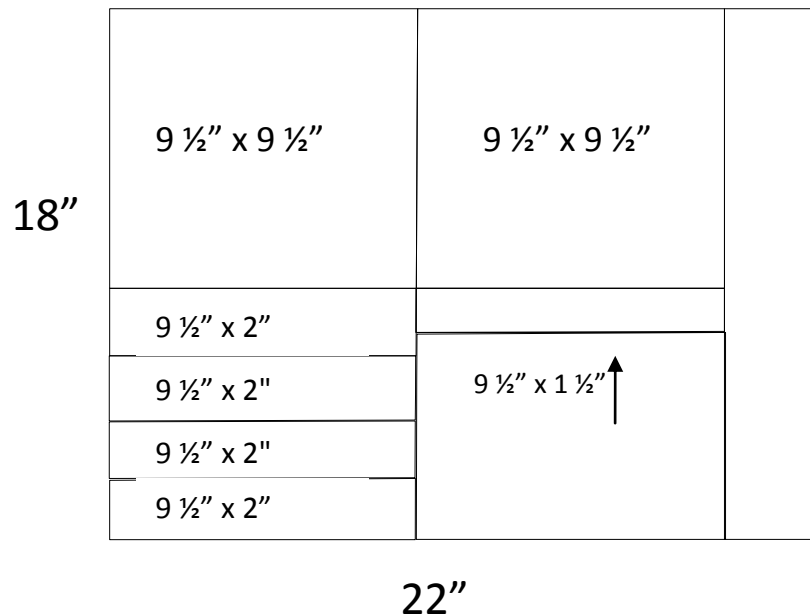
SUPPLIES:

- One background fat quarter
- Dark brown fabric with stars approximately 10" x 7".
- Scraps of off-white, orange, green, and brown fabric.
- Lightweight fusible web.
- Off-white embroidery floss.
- Cotton batting approximately 10" x 3".
- Pencil.
- Embroidery needle.
- 10" x 13" pillow form. See www.patchplayquilting.com for a free pattern for the pillow form.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut one 10" x 3" piece from dark brown fabric. Trace the embroidery design found at the end of these instructions on this piece of fabric using a light box or window.
2. Place the 10" x 3" piece of batting behind the 10" x 3" piece of dark brown fabric. Pin if needed.
3. Embroider the words and the moons with two strands of off-white floss. You will be embroidering through the batting as well. Trim this piece to 9½" x 2½".
4. On fusible web trace one 3" circle, one 1" x 1 ½" oval, one 1" circle, and one 1 ½" circle.
5. Fuse a 1" square on green scrap.
6. Fuse a 10" by 3" rectangle on brown scrap.
7. Fuse and cut one 3" circle from off-white fabric.
8. Fuse and cut one 1" x 1 ½" oval from orange fabric.
9. Fuse and cut one 1" circle from orange fabric.
10. Fuse and cut one 1 ½" circle from orange fabric.
11. Fuse and cut three stem shapes from green fabric.
12. Fuse and cut fence posts and fence rails from brown fabric approximately ½" wide using wavy lines. You will need two rails approximately 10 inches long and three fence posts approximately 2 ½" long.

13. Cut one 3 ½" by 9 ½" piece from dark brown fabric.
14. Following picture fuse moon, fence rails, fence posts, pumpkins and stems to dark brown fabric in that order.
15. Using matching thread machine buttonhole stitch around all fused shapes.
15. Cut background fat quarter following the diagram below.



16. Sew the 9½" x 1½" strip to the bottom of the embroidered word strip. Then sew the appliquéd strip (9 ½" by 3 ½") to the bottom of that 9½" x 1½" strip.
13. Sew a 9½" x 2" strip to the top of the embroidered word strip and to the bottom of the sunflower blocks strip.
14. Sew a 9½" x 2" strip to each side. This will complete the pillow top.
15. Press a double ½" inch hem on one side of both 9½" x 9½" squares. Sew along this folded edge.
16. With right sides together pin a 9½" square to the pillow top along one short side. Pin the second 9½" square to the other short side of the pillow top. The hem edges should overlap in the middle. Sew around all four sides of the pillow top.
17. Turn right sides out. Smooth out corners with a blunt pair of scissors. Insert pillow form.
