PILLOW TALK

9" X 12"

SEPTEMBER

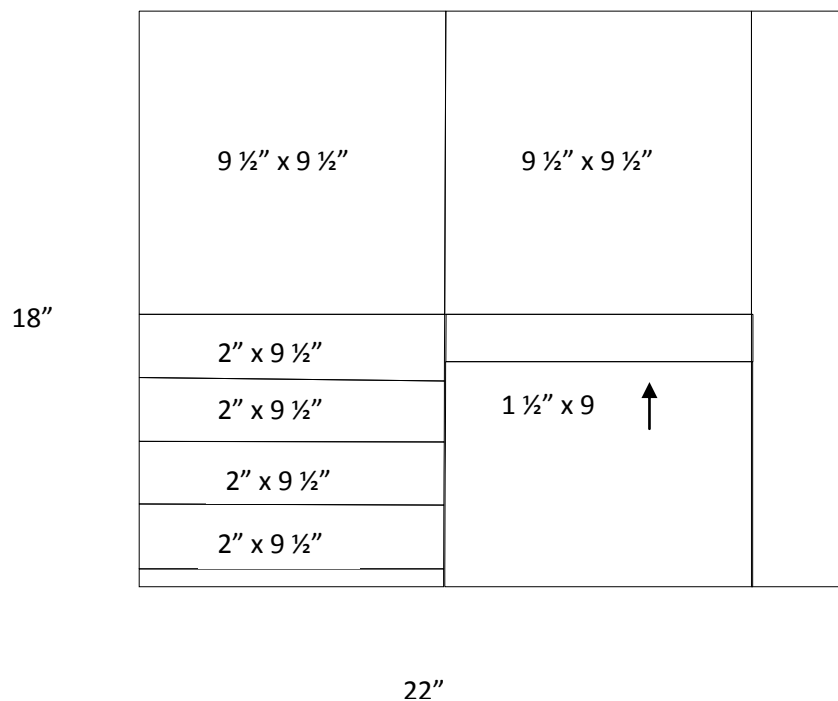
SUPPLIES:

- One apple print fat quarter.
- Solid white fabric approximately 10" x 10".
- One 6" x 6" piece of each of the following fabrics: red print, yellow print, green print.
- Apple core template. See page 4.
- Red embroidery floss.
- Brown embroidery floss.
- Green embroidery floss.
- Fusible web.
- Iron
- Sharp scissors.
- Cotton batting approximately 10" x 3".
- Pencil
- Embroidery needle.
- 10" x 13" pillow form. See www.patchplayquilting.com for a free pattern for the pillow form.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut one 10" x 3" piece from white fabric. Trace the embroidery design found at the end of these instructions on this piece of fabric using a light box or window.
2. Place the 10" x 3" piece of batting behind the 10" x 3" piece of white fabric. Pin if needed.
3. Embroider the words with two strands of the brown floss and the apples with two strands of the red and brown floss, using a backstitch. Embroider the green leaf with two strands of floss, using the lazy daisy stitch. You will be embroidering through the batting as well. Trim this piece to 9½" x 2½".
4. From white fabric cut a 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" strip of fabric.
5. Trace the apple core templates twelve times on the paper side of fusible web.
6. Cut around the shape leaving approximately 1/4". Remove the paper backing and iron four apple core shape to each of the green, red and yellow fabric. Use the picture as a guide.

7. Cut out each shape on the traced line and using the picture as a guide iron the apple cores to the 3 1/2" x 9 1/2" strip of white fabric.
8. Cut the apple print fat quarter following the diagram below.

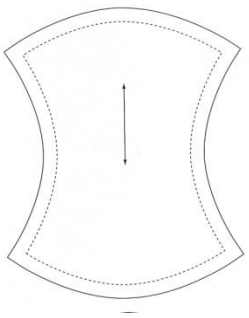


9. Sew the 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" apple print strip to the bottom of the embroidered word strip.
10. Sew the apple core strip to the bottom of the 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" blue strip.
11. Sew a 2" x 9 1/2" strip to the top of the embroidered word strip and to the bottom of the star strip.
12. Sew a 2" x 9 1/2" strip to each side. This completes the pillow top.
13. Press a double 1/2" inch hem on one side of both 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" squares. Sew along this folded edge.

14. With right sides together pin a 9½” square to the pillow top along one short side. Pin the second 9½” square to the other short side of the pillow top. The hem edges should overlap in the middle. Sew around all four sides of the pillow top.

15. Turn right sides out. Smooth out corners with a blunt pair of scissors. Insert pillow form.
