



PATCHPLAY

BECAUSE QUILTING SHOULD ALWAYS BE FUN



JINGLE BELL SQUARE

14" X 14"

WREATH BLOCK

SUPPLIES:

- Approximately forty five 3 1/2" squares of assorted green fabrics.
- 14" x 14" square of beige background fabric.
- 8" x 15" piece of red fabric.
- 7 1/2" circle Patchplay Shapeplay Template.
- Small Clover Quick Yo-yo Maker.
- Nine red 3/8" buttons.
- Green hand quilting thread.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Make approximately 45 yo-yos with the 3 1/2" squares of green fabric, the Small Clover Quick Yo-yo maker and the green hand quilting thread. Instructions are included with the yo-yo maker.
2. Center the 7 1/2" Shapeplay Template on the background fabric square. Trace around the template lightly with a pencil.
3. Using matching thread appliqué approximately 19 yo-yos around the inside of the circle with one edge of each yo-yo just touching the circle and each yo-yo touching the one next to it. You may have to overlap slightly towards the end to make them fit. The appliqué stitches can be fairly big, approximately 1/4".
4. Appliqué approximately 25 yo-yos to the outside of the previous yo-yo circle overlapping both the previous circle of yo-yos and each yo-yo next to it.
5. Trim the background to 12 1/2" square.
6. Cut two 2" x 12 1/2" strips and two 2" x 14 1/2" strips from the red fabric.
7. Sew a 2" x 12 1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the background fabric.
8. Sew a 2" x 14 1/2" strip to the left and right sides of the background fabric.
9. Trim the block to 14 1/2" square.
9. Using the picture as a guide add the red buttons.
