JINGLE BELL SQUARE

Welcome to Jingle Bell Square! This is our 2012 Block of the Month wallhanging. It is a very scrappy quilt with lots of different fabrics. Our quilt was made using Nancy Halverson's Jingle All The Way fabric from Benartex. The fabric yardages listed in the following supplies is the minimum amount needed of each color for the whole quilt to give a little variety. The more variety of fabrics you use the better it will be.

SUPPLIES:

Fabric:

- 1 1/4 yards of red for borders and binding.
- 1 yard of beige for block backgrounds.
- 4 green fat quarters for blocks.
- 3 red fat quarters for blocks.
- 2 gold fat quarters for blocks.
- 1 blue fat quarter for blocks.
- 3 yards for backing.

Threads:

- 3 yards red acrylic yarn.
- 1 1/2 yards gold cord.
- Gold metallic thread.
- Green and brown 50 wt. rayon embroidery thread.
- Green hand quilting thread.
- Invisible thread.

Embellishments and tools:

- Three 1/4" gold buttons.
- Nine 3/8" red buttons.
- 9 mm knitting needle.
- Heat resistant template plastic.
- Liquid starch.
- Small paint brush.
- 12" x 12" fusible web.
- Clover Quick Yo-yo maker.
- Quilt in a Day Scallops, Vines and Waves Template.
